

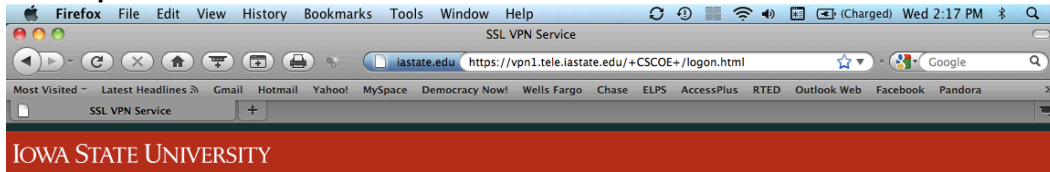
# Remote Desktop Connection Instructions for Mac users

Step 1: Download and install remote Desktop Connection Client 2 from:

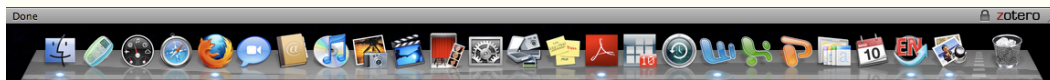

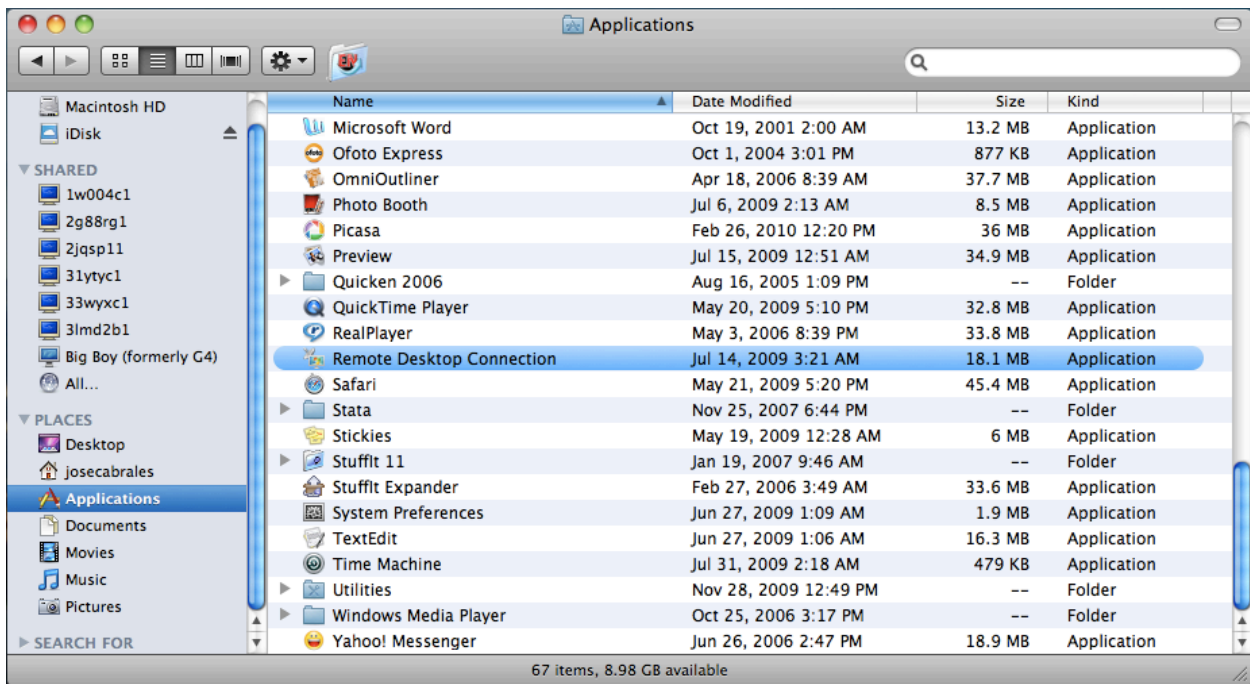

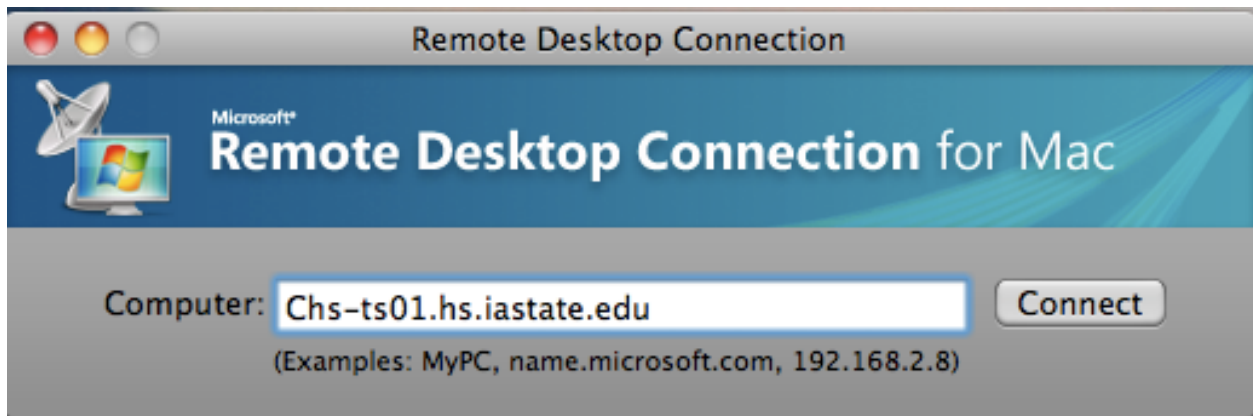


**Note: Let it install Java applets. After it shows that you have connected open Remote Desktop client**

**Step 3: Click on your Finder (  ) and Go to Applications>Remote Desktop Connection**

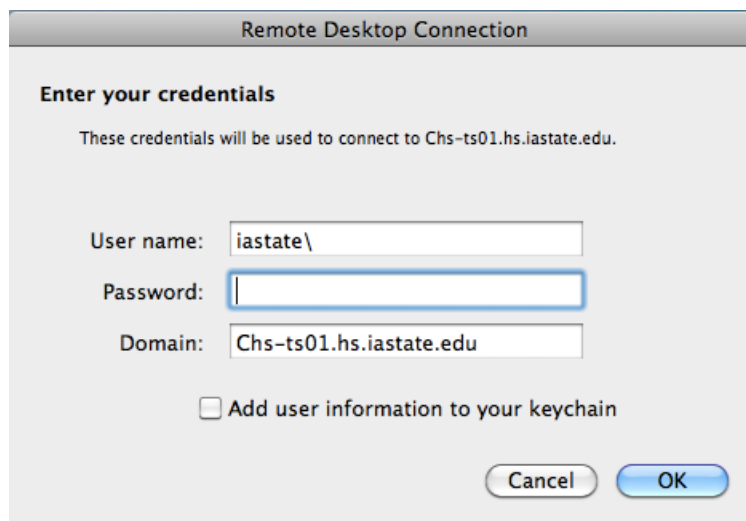


**Step 4:** For the computer name enter: Chs-ts01.hs.iastate.edu (Note: That is a zero after the ts)



**Step 5:** Click the “connect” button

**Step 6:** Enter your ISU NetID as the username: (You may need to add iastate\ in front of your NetID)  
Enter your password



**Step 7: You should now be connected** (Double Click on whichever program you would like to use: Stata or SPSS)
