## create

## Tips for completing the form

- You don't have an ISU ID yet so leave that box blank.
- On the first screen, be sure to select Fall 2010 and the options shown in this box:

- You'll need names and contact info for 3 references. Your primary reference must be a PK-12 school administrator. Where it says 'Use online process?', select NO.
- Skip Section 6 (Activities) and the Statement of Purpose part of Section 7.
- Print 2 copies of this completed screen **before** you click on SUBMIT.

## request

Request official copies of your transcripts to be sent by the universities you have attended (this is an ISU graduate school requirement). [15 minutes]
