

Before Interview Days

1. Submit the Interview Days Registration Form online on or before Friday, February 1, 2008.
2. Submit a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) form <www.fafsa.ed.gov> as soon as possible.
3. Arrange travel to/from Ames for I-Days as soon as you are admitted to the program (please note that admittance to the program constitutes an invitation to I-Days) It is important that you attend I-Days.
4. Review the Iowa State University and Higher Education websites so that any questions that arise can be addressed.
5. If you have any questions or concerns feel free to contact the I-Days coordinator.

Attire

Be sure to check weather reports before packing, as it could and probably will be cold. It is Iowa, however, so it could also be mild!

Thursday: Business Casual (khakis/dress slacks/skirts/etc.)

Friday: Business Attire/Interview appropriate (suits/dress clothes)

Suggestions on what to bring

- clothes/toiletries etc.
- thank-you notes to write after your interviews
- copies of your résumé
- coat/hat/gloves
- sheets/towels/sleeping bags/pillows etc. will be provided by hotel or host but feel free to bring your own

During Interview Days

1. Participate in scheduled events.
2. Relax and be yourself during your interviews.
3. Have fun and enjoy getting to know your future colleagues!
4. Prepare a list of questions to ask during your interviews.
5. Read the job descriptions for all positions for which you're interviewing (note: some offices interview for multiple positions).
6. Remember, this is the beginning of your professional career, conduct yourself in a professional manner.

After Interview Days

1. Please do not attempt to contact departments for your offer status. Departments will contact you with any offers approximately two weeks after I-Days.
2. Keep the Interview Days Coordinator updated on offers you've received and accepted.
